- He had a lot of problems with law
- He died in 1638
- Invetions:
 - 1. Telescope
 - 2. Microscope

MIKROSCKOPE

- a single-lens (simple)
- Janssen invented it with the help of his father in 1595
- The patent was denied
- origin of the microscope is a matter of debate
- Construction :
 - 2 tubes that gave a magnification of 10 X
 - the lens : bi-convex and plano-convex

- Marcelo Malpighi analysis of biological structures
- Antoni van Leeuwenhoek discovered red blood cells and spermatozoa
